Dear Parents,

We would like to remind you of our policy that, in general, pupils are not allowed to bring electrical items into school. They have no need of them during the school day and there is the risk of them being misplaced.

There is one exception to this policy which is that children who are travelling to and from school on the bus or with a driver may, if their parents wish, bring a mobile telephone with them so that parents and child can contact each other during the journey. However, these phones must be declared via the form below and they must be handed in to the Front Hall desk for safekeeping during the school day. They should be named and we recommend that you use the simplest phone possible.

Please note that we reserve the right to confiscate any undeclared mobile phones which are found in a pupil's possession. These will be returned at a later date. Please also note that the school will not accept any responsibility for loss of, or damage to, any phones which are brought into school.
