Sun safety

Children should wear sunhats and a sunscreen with a sun protection factor (SPF) of at least 30.

Insist that your child wears sunglasses to protect his / her eyes from the sun. Choose shades that offer UV protection.

Limit exposure to the sun during peak sunshine hours. This is normally from 10 am until 4 pm. Don't mistake a cloudy day for a sun free day. UV rays travel through the clouds and can burn your child's skin.

Take time in the shade. Tents, umbrellas and trees can provide time outs from the sun. Be sure to take frequent shade breaks during your time outdoors.

Keep your kids hydrated. Offer frequent water breaks and be sure your child drinks lots of water when playing outdoors.
